Virgin Trains. In September 1914, to mark the centenary of the start of WW1, Virgin Trains named one of their engines on the East Coast line between Edinburgh Waverley and Kings Cross London 'For the Fallen'. The specially painted train carried the cap badges of five Regiments whose recruiting areas the route passed through, one of which was The Royal Scots. It also had a painting of Lcpl Jim Boyd 16RS, and a Hearts player, together with the last Field Message Card he sent home, on the side. Thistle Winter 2014/15.
