COVID-19 - Scottish Govt Policy

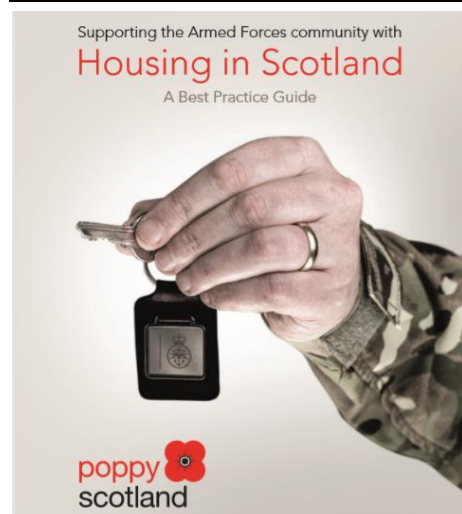
Indoor non-office workplaces, street-access shops, outdoor markets/sports courts/playgrounds open, if guidance is implemented. Registration offices open for high priority. Marriages/civil partnerships allowed with minimal attendees - outdoors. Zoos/gardens open for local access (5 miles). Travel distance to relax on 3 July when self-catering accommodation and second homes (without shared facilities) permitted.

Forces Help to Buy

All regular serving personnel who have completed 12 mths service are now eligible to apply for the Forces Help to Buy scheme.

The scheme allows regular serving personnel to borrow an interest-free deposit of up to half their annual salary, to buy their own home. The loan, which has to be repaid over 10 years, is capped at £25,000.

Cycle 75 miles to commemorate the 75th anniversary of Victory over Japan Day (VJ Day) on 15 August and raise vital funds for veteran's mental health.



VJ Day 1945 marked the end of the Second World War, with British troops returning home bearing the physical and psychological scars of combat, traumatised by what they had experienced.

To commemorate VJ Day and raise funds to continue its life-changing services, Combat Stress launched a new virtual cycling event.

Ride to Victory has no physical race start line. How and where you complete the challenge is up to you. Cycle 75 miles in a day, beat a personal best by cycling 75 miles as fast as possible, or turn it into a team challenge and divide the distance between your family – the possibilities are endless.

Register online, dust off the bicycle, and get started. The event costs £20 (or £16 early bird) to register to take part. Those who reach £750 will receive a special commemorative 'Hero's Poppy'.
